Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This week you will receive your child's report for Semester 1.

Please find the information below about the Reporting Schedule for the year.

Through consultation with school staff and the P&C in 2024, Canungra State School's reporting schedule remains as follows in 2025:

Sem 1

- **Term 2 --Academic report** (including the student's achievement against the reporting scale; results for behaviour and effort; **without comments**)
- **Term 3 – Parent/Teacher Interviews**

Sem 2

- **Term 4 – Parent Open Afternoon** – parents can visit children's classrooms. Children will share their progress and achievements with parents from 2.15- 2:45. Parents can then stay to discuss their child's achievement and progress with the teacher from 2:45- 4:15.
- **Term 4 – Academic report** (including the student's achievement against the reporting scale; results for behaviour and effort; **without comments**)

Academic reporting is about communication to parents and students about achievement and progress in the curriculum provided. Academic reports provide point in time information about achievement against the expected standards at the end of each reporting period. Opportunities for discussions with parents provide a means to communicate achievement and progress.

The Academic report will include:

- each learning area/subject provided in the Semester
- the student's achievement against the reporting scale
- results for behaviour and effort

Academic reports reflect:

- on-balance judgements about the quality of student learning, based on evidence collected during the reporting period
- the student's most consistent achievement with consideration to more recent evidence
- the achievement awarded using the appropriate reporting scale. Schools use an A–E or equivalent scale to report achievement on academic reports.

- The scale acknowledges the range of performance against the relevant standard.
