Cybersafety and Social Media

As a school community we are continuously working with students around positive behaviour expectations. One of the most complex situations we face, alongside parents, is social media. I am reaching out to all parents to assist with supporting you and your children to better understand and navigate age-appropriate and respectful use of social media.

I strongly encourage all parents to take the time to look at all the information provided on this site. Of great importance is the fact that for nearly all social media apps, the age restrictions for children are that they must be at least 13yrs old to use them. This means that only a very small percentage of primary school children should have social media apps at all. Parents, I know this is a complex situation for you in this day and age, however, the number of issues and incidents that are occurring between students is increasing, and is having a major effect on the wellbeing of students at this school. Please think carefully before allowing your children to use social media. Please utilise the link below to educate yourselves around all of these apps and the steps you can take to protect your children and educate them on appropriate behaviour.

As per our Student Code of Conduct, whilst social media incidents mostly occur outside of school hours and off-site, these incidents can adversely affect other students and the good order and management of the school. As a result, school consequences can be applied.

Amelie (2C) for her diligent effort to complete all learning tasks to a high standard.


